Be very attentive to the many details and insights that the apostle John shares with you in this passage, he gives us answers and clues to this very rare outburst of Jesus. The Lord knows our heart, everything is in view for Him, and he burns with zeal for us, because He is a God of love. The Song of songs reads; 'For love is as strong as death,...The flames of love are flames of fire, a blaze that comes from the Lord.' Perhaps, this passage doesn't mention the word 'love', but to me, it is all about it. I invite you to be a passive recipient to this passage and let it strike you, with all it has. Maybe the Lord will reveal something of Himself to you. Listen.
